This week I am delighted to inform you that Matt has also been chosen as one of only three secondary school students to go on a trip to the sub-Antarctic islands on board a Royal NZ Navy ship in a joint initiative with the Royal Society of New Zealand.



The HMNZS WELLINGTON will begin its journey in Bluff on 6 December and end its voyage in Dunedin on 12 December. Along the way the ship will visit some of the sub-Antarctic islands including Campbell, Auckland and Enderby Islands. During the week students will be involved in activities working alongside Department of Conservation staff who will also be travelling on the ship.

Dr Di McCarthy, Chief Executive of the Royal Society of New Zealand said “We were very impressed by the high calibre of the candidates and their keenness to undertake the voyage.

‘The Great Debate 2010’



Candidate Information Booklets and Admission Slips will be issued to students on November 11. Level 1 Candidates will also receive a Marking External Assessment Pilot information sheet

Students should notify the school urgently if they notice any errors on their Admission Slips or they have a change of address. NZQA must be notified of any name corrections.

Students should use their learner login to order certificate(s), or copies of their **Record of Achievement**, or **School Results Summary** from January 2011. These are no longer automatically sent to students. Students will be sent a **Result Notice** automatically.
