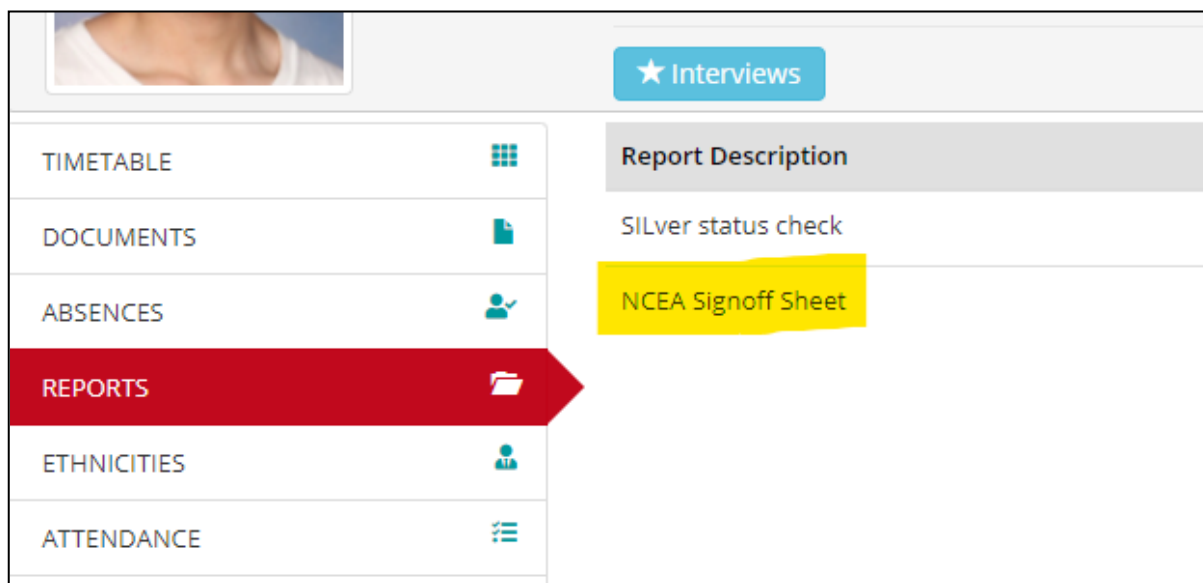
#### Senior Exams

We are very pleased and proud of the way students have approached their exams this week. If a student has missed an exam we are making arrangements for them to sit these on Monday and Tuesday next week. Parents will be contacted and students will be emailed with the details of the rooms and times.

#### NCEA Signoff Sheet

A reminder to parents of seniors about the messages I emailed you last term. **Seniors will be signed off individually by a Deputy Principal when they are ready to leave school. This could be any time between 6<sup>th</sup> November – 8<sup>th</sup> December.** Classes are continuing to run to support students who still need credits for their qualification, as a result of the lockdowns. Parents should be regularly consulting their student's **NCEA Signoff Sheet on Spider**. It signals if students are signed off and if not, what still needs to be completed. It includes a detailed summary of the credits and qualifications gained and an explanation of the Extra Learning Recognition Credit system for 2020.

To access the form, log in to Spider and access the Student information screen. Under their photo, choose **Reports** and **NCEA Signoff Sheet** and **Quick Print**. See below. This will generate a pdf of the form.

## Selwyn Celebrates Outstanding Mathematics Successes

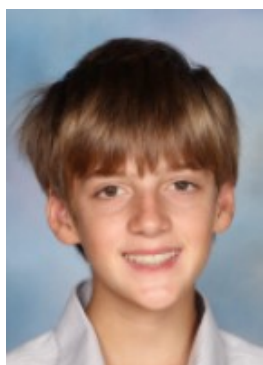

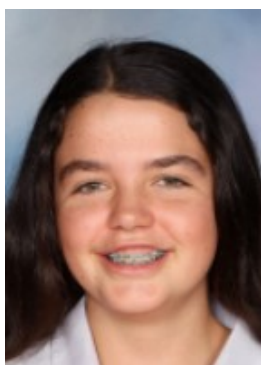
We also had students participate in the Education Perfect Maths Championship for 2020 with some awesome results.

Gold Awards for the top 2% of 107,000 competitors around the world were won by **Noa Strey** and **Jenny Wu**.



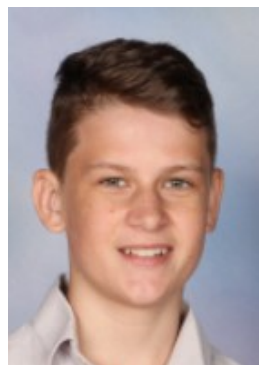
