

A Colourful 'Trip Around the World'

Term 3 Mid Term Break and Senior Exams are Coming Up

All Selwyn whanau and families are reminded that next Friday 23rd August is mid-term break and that the Senior School Exams are running from Monday 26th August to Thursday 29th August.

Seven ways to study effectively

Be positive

Be active – memorise actively not passively

Don't just read silently – use your other senses.

Picture what you are learning in your mind (try mind maps).

Read aloud and listen to yourself.

Use association – relate facts to things you know e.g. dates to ones you already know, or make up catch phrases and codes that help you to remember lists.

Discuss the main points with a friend and test each other.

Record your summaries on tape.

Teach the topic to someone else e.g. Mum or the cat.

Condition yourself

Try to study at the time in the same place each day.

Spend only approximately thirty minutes at a time studying and keep alert by taking frequent breaks

During the breaks in which you relax you will subconsciously absorb what you have studied.

Plan your study time

Know what you want to achieve and how you will do this.

Develop your own note-taking system

If you make good notes throughout the year, they will be invaluable for revision.

Early in the year develop your own system

Colour coding e.g. red for main ideas, blue for dates and umbers.

Underlining main points.

Using sub-headings and numbered points.

Using a consistent system of abbreviations of common words e.g. 'w' for 'with'.

Review

Study your notes the same day after your lessons and at frequent intervals thereafter.

Question yourself on facts – it helps!

MEASLES



More than 20 schools in Auckland have had one or more cases of measles.

*This is a timely reminder.....*The best protection against measles is to be vaccinated with two doses of the measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccine. In New Zealand, the MMR vaccine is routinely given to children at 15 months and four years old.
