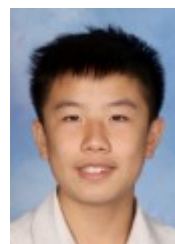

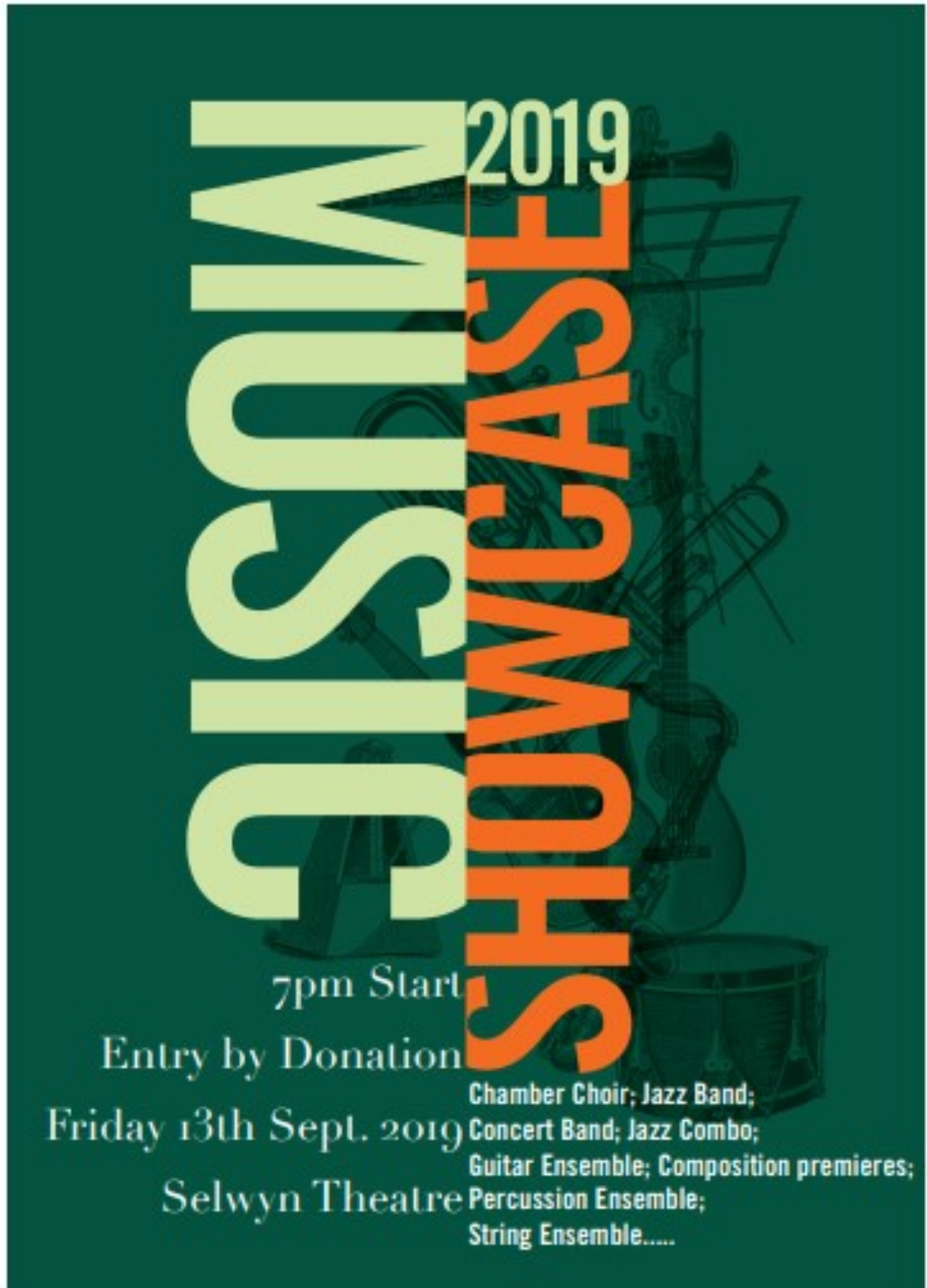


Invitation to the Music Showcase - Friday 13th September at 7pm

Growing for a Cause

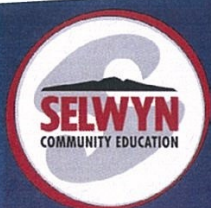
Thursday 10 October
