A Special Rose Day

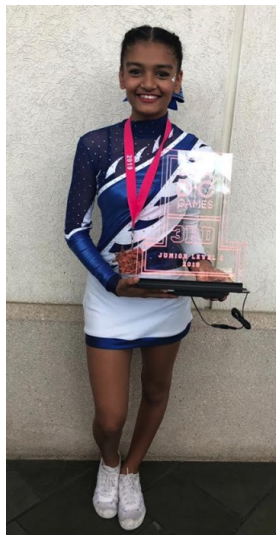
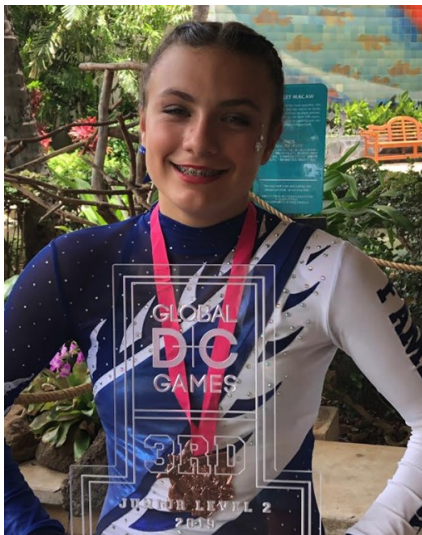
