After many hours of cake decorating, Alex also baked his way into gain a Bronze for his Lemon, Cardamom and Pistachio biscuits.

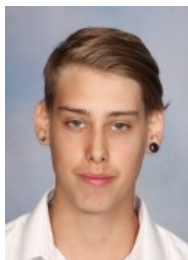
Congratulations Alex, we are very proud of you!
